NEW ITEMS FOR SALE

There are two new releases that will become available shortly.

Career-Spanning Boxed Set of JD hits; John Denver will get the deluxe box-set treatment this fall. The four-CD All of My Memories: The John Denver Collection, due Nov. 4 from RCA/Legacy Recordings, will contain 90 songs spanning the entirety of the late singer's career, including six previously unreleased tracks.


The tracks on All My Memories draw from 31 albums and cover the years 1964, when he made a pair of demo recordings for Capitol Records, to 1997, the year of his death. In addition to the hits he regularly had on pop and country radio — like chart-toppers Annie's Song, Thank God I'm a Country Boy and I'm Sorry — they include live performances and promotional rarities, as well as limited-edition and private-pressing recordings. These six tracks have never seen commercial release:

- Cover versions of The Road and Far Side of the Hill, two 1964 demos recorded for Capitol Records in Hollywood, prior to joining the Mitchell Trio:
- An early version of Rhymes and Reasons, cut in early '69 for Reprise Records and re-done as the title track of his debut LP for RCA later that year;
- A live version of Spirit recorded at the Sydney Opera House in 1977 but not included on the 1999 concert album release;
- An alternate take of Eli's Song from 1976; and
- A 1973 of the standard It's A Sin to Tell a Lie, the 1955 Somethin' Smith and the Redheads version of which was his mother's favorite record.

SOUTH DAKOTA'S FIRST 'MAKE A WISH' FAMILY CELEBRATES 30TH ANNIVERSARY

Make-A-Wish South Dakota is celebrating 30 years of granting wishes for children facing a life-threatening illness in our state.

This Saturday, Make-A-Wish families, donors and volunteers got together in Sioux Falls to celebrate the outstanding impact the organization has had in South Dakota.

"Back in 1984 we granted six wishes a year, today we grant anywhere from 60 to 70 wishes a year. We've granted a total of 1100 wishes since 1984," Paul Krueger, the President of Make-A-Wish South Dakota said. Some of the special guests at this weekend's anniversary celebration were Richard and Janice Olsen, the parents of Krista. Krista was the first Make-A-Wish recipient in South Dakota.

Although 30 years have passed since her wish was granted, the Olsen family is a testament to

how long a wish's special memories can last. "Krista was our firstborn, beautiful daughter diagnosed with cancer when she was 12 years old." said Janice Olsen.

The Viborg teen suffered through many surgeries and hospital says over the next four years of her life; but her parents say there was one bright memory from those days.

"We were at home and it was Christmas eve day there was a knock on the door and two ladies showed up and said they were with Make-A-Wish...the asked her who her favorite entertainer was and she said John Denver," said Richard

"Two ladies form back east some place explained what the organization was able to do and wanted her to be the first SD child and we were just in awe. That doesn't happen to the normal South Dakota farmer child," said Janice.

Krista, her family and one of her closest friends flew to Colorado to meet her favorite star, John Denver.

"He spent a little more than an hour with us...he sang several songs and gave Krista several albums and was just a very congenial guy....we managed to go skiing on the slopes there at Aspen...we had a wonderful time and she had some wonderful memories," said Richard.

"They made her feel so special and just it was a joy to watch her face, her excitement after having to go through so many surgeries and hard things she had to go through," said Janice.

While Make-A-Wish and all of the media attention made Krista feel extra special...it's the way her family has always felt.

"She's always been special, she is a very intelligent girl, loved to play piano, ride horse, she was a very capable student and everything but this happened to her and she dealt with it like nothing that I could ever do. She dealt with it courageously," said Richard.

It's the kind of courage many South Dakota kids still share today.

"My hope is for all the kids we serve in SD that the wish is something that really helps them get through their battle and the family too, because when a child is sick it really impacts the whole family," said Krueger.

Over the past 30 years, Make-A-Wish South Dakota has granted more than 1100 wishes to kids battling a life-threatening illness.
